Jesus Healing Individuals
Part 2

John 5:19 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.

The Nobleman's son
The Unclean spirit in church
Peter's mother-in-law
The Leper
The Paralyzed man through roof

#6 John 5:2 Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, which is called in Hebrew, Bethesda, having five porches.

3 In these lay a great multitude of sick people, blind, lame, paralyzed, waiting for the moving of the water.

#6 John 5:4 For an angel went down at a certain time into the pool and stirred up the water; then whoever stepped in first, after the stirring of the water, was made well of whatever disease he had.

#6 John 5:5 Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity thirty-eight years. 6 When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, "Do you want to be made well?"

#6 John 5:7 The sick man answered Him, "Sir, I have no man to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up; but while I am coming, another steps down before me."

#6 John 5:8 Jesus said to him, "Rise, take up your bed and walk."

9 And immediately the man was made well, took up his bed, and walked. And that day was the Sabbath.

#John 5:10 The Jews therefore said to him who was cured, "It is the Sabbath; it is not lawful for you to carry your bed."

11 He answered them, "He who made me well said to me, 'Take up your bed and walk.'"

#6 John 5:12 Then they asked him, "Who is the Man who said to you, 'Take up your bed and walk'?" 13 But the one who was healed did not know who it was, for Jesus had withdrawn, a multitude being in that place.

#6 John 5:14 Afterward Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, "See, you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you."

#6 John 5:15 The man departed and told the Jews that it was Jesus who had made him well.

#6 John 5:16 For this reason the Jews persecuted Jesus, and sought to kill Him, because He had done these things on the Sabbath.

#6 John 5:19 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.

#6 Observations:

1. Two paraplegic in a row
2. Three clearly different healing "systems" at work
3. 38 years - Creative miracle in being made whole
4. It was the Sabbath and it was initiated by the Father
5. His sin and sickness were associated
6. Is it possible that all could have been healed that day?
7. This was initiated by the Father- He knew it was the Sabbath!

#7. Matt 12; Mark 3; Luke 6 - Man With A Withered Hand

Luke 6:6 Now it happened on another Sabbath, also, that He entered the synagogue and taught. And a man was there whose right hand was withered.

Luke 6:7 So the scribes and Pharisees watched Him closely, whether He would heal on the Sabbath, that they might find an accusation against Him.

Luke 6:8 But He knew their thoughts, and said to the man who had the withered hand, "Arise and stand here." And he arose and stood.

Luke 6:9 Then Jesus said to them, "I will ask you one thing: Is it lawful on the Sabbath to do good or to do evil, to save life or to destroy?"

Luke 6:10 And when He had looked around at them all, He said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he did so, and his hand was restored as whole as the other.

Luke 6:11 But they were filled with rage, and discussed with one another what they might do to Jesus. (Matt 12 and plotted against Him, how they might destroy Him.)

#7 Observations

1. Could it be the Father's intentions are to give them an chance to change?
2. Healing is both doing Good and a form of saving life
3. The man was willing to pay whatever price might come.
4. Jesus had him do something!
5. He spoke to the withered arm
6. How the Father and Jesus handled the Sabbath & Healing...

#8. Matt 8; Luke 7; The

Centurion's Servant Matt. 8:5 Now when Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him,

Matt 8:6 saying, "Lord, my servant is lying at home paralyzed, dreadfully tormented."
7 And Jesus said to him, "I will come and heal him."

Matt 8:8 The centurion answered and said, "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed.

Matt 8:9 For I also am a man under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."

Matt 8:10 When Jesus heard it, He marveled, and said to those who followed, "Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!

Matt 8:11 And I say to you that many will come from east and west, and sit down with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven.

Matt 8:12 But the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

Matt 8:13 Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you." And his servant was healed that same hour.

#8. Observations:

1. Back in Capernaum again!
2. His servant - possibly a Jew
3. He understood power &

authority

4. Healing not based on need or qualifications
5. A refreshing pause (such great faith) and warning to those in authority in Israel.
6. Jesus spoke to the needed healing.

#9. Dead Man Raised Luke 7:11 Now it happened, the day after, that He went into a city called Nain; and many of His disciples went with Him, and a large crowd.

Luke 7:12 And when He came near the gate of the city, behold, a dead man was being carried out, the only son of his mother; and she was a widow. And a large crowd from the city was with her.

Luke 7:13 When the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep."

Luke 7:14 Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried him stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise."

Luke 7:15 So he who was dead sat up and began to speak. And He presented him to his mother.

Luke 7:16 Then fear came upon all, and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has risen up among us"; and, "God has visited His people."

Luke 7:17 And this report about Him went throughout all Judea and all the surrounding region.

#9. Observations

1. First dead person He raised.
2. On the way from Galilee to Jerusalem.
3. He sensed the Father's prompt - Compassion

#9. Observations

4. He "acted in faith" saying Do not weep to the mother!
5. He spoke to the son - "arise"
6. The timing and extended impact are noteworthy!

#10. Matt 12; Luke 11 Blind and Mute Man Healed Matt 12:22 Then one was brought to Him who was demon-possessed, blind and mute; and He healed him, so that the blind and mute man both spoke and saw.

Matt 12:23 And all the multitudes were amazed and said, "Could this be the Son of David?"

Matt 12:24 Now when the Pharisees heard it they said, "This fellow does not cast out demons except by Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons."

Matt 12:25 But Jesus knew their thoughts, and said to them: "Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation, and every city or house divided against itself will not stand.

Matt 12:26 If Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself. How then will his kingdom stand?

Matt 12:27 And if I cast out demons by Beelzebub, by whom do your sons cast them out? Therefore they shall be your judges.

Matt 12:28 But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.

Matt 12:30 He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters abroad.

#10. Observations

1. This tormented one was brought to Jesus.
2. The crowd wondered / verbalized if this was not the Messiah/King

#10. Observations

3. The opposition could not disregard the miracle so they defamed the real source
