Hebrews 1:3 who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, NASV

...the exact representation of His being... NIV

...He is the perfect imprint and very image of [God's] nature... AMP

#2. Matthew 8:16-17
Mark 1:32-34
Luke 4:40-41

Matthew 8:16 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick,

Matthew 8:17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses."

Mark 1:32 At evening, when the sun had set, they brought to Him all who were sick and those who were demon-possessed.

33 And the whole city was gathered together at the door.

Mark 1:34 Then He healed many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him.

Luke 4:40 When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them.

Luke 4:41 And demons also came out of many, crying out and saying, "You are the Christ, the Son of God!" And He, rebuking them, did not allow them to speak, for they knew that He was the Christ.

Conclusions:

1. These three accounts are the same time period.
2. He spoke to the demon spirits
3. He laid hands on all the sick
4. At sundown - Not the sabbath

#1 Matthew 4:23
Mark 1:39

Mark 1:39 And He was preaching in their synagogues throughout all Galilee, and casting out demons.

Matthew 4:23 Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.

#10. Leper Healed first, then:

Luke 5:15 However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by Him of their infirmities.

#4. Matthew 12:15
Mark 3:7-12

Matthew 12:15 But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all.

Mark 3:7 But Jesus withdrew with His disciples to the sea. And a great multitude from Galilee followed Him, and from Judea

Mark 3:8 and Jerusalem and Idumea and beyond the Jordan; and those from Tyre and Sidon, a great multitude, when they heard how many things He was doing, came to Him.

Mark 3:9 So He told His disciples that a small boat should be kept ready for Him because of the multitude, lest they should crush Him. 10 For He healed many, so that as many as had afflictions pressed about Him to touch Him.

Mark 3:11 And the unclean spirits, whenever they saw Him, fell down before Him and cried out, saying, "You are the Son of God." 12 But He sternly warned them that they should not make Him known.

#11. Luke 6:17-19

Luke 6:17 And He came down with them and stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon,

Luke 6:17b ...who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases,

Luke 6:18 as well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were healed.

Luke 6:19 And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed them all.

#6. Matthew 14:35-36
Mark 6:53

Matthew 14:35 And when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent out into all that surrounding region, brought to Him all who were sick,

Matthew 14:36 and begged Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched it were made perfectly well.

Mark 6:53 When they had crossed over, they came to the land of Gennesaret and anchored there.

Mark 6:54 And when they came out of the boat, immediately the people recognized Him,

Mark 6:55 ran through that whole surrounding region, and began to carry about on beds those who were sick to wherever they heard He was.

Mark 6:56 Wherever He entered, into villages, cities, or the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might just touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched Him were made well.

#12. Luke 7:21
Jesus Answers John's Inquiry

Luke 7:21 And that very hour He cured many of infirmities, afflictions, and evil spirits; and to many blind He gave sight

Luke 7:22 Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things you have seen and heard: that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, the poor have the gospel preached to them.

#5. Matthew 14:14
Luke 9:11

Matthew 14:14 And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.

Luke 9:11 But when the multitudes knew it, they followed Him; and He received them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who had need of healing.

#14. Luke 17:12-17

Luke 17:12 Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. 13 And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

Luke 17:14 So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed.

Luke 17:15 And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God,

Luke 17:16 and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan.

Luke 17:17 So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine?"

Luke 17:18 Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?"

Luke 17:19 And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."
