And God says in the days to come and the years to come that God's going to call you and your church just to... God's just going to speak to you and say, "Do this," and you'll do it. I'm not talking about long-term programs, I'm talking about short-term God says, "Do this" and you'll do it. Hallelujah. And I just see the Lord, that you're in a place of flexibility. You're in a place of total abandonment to the Holy Ghost and total abandonment to the will of God, hallelujah. And there's an ability, there's a freedom, there's a freedom, there's a freedom, hallelujah, that God's going to use. Whereas some others are still having to stand in the area of finances and having to struggle in the area of finances. And indeed God calls some people to take financial leaps of faith, but the Lord says you're going to be able to respond just like that (he snaps his fingers) just in the twinkling of an eye, in just a moment, in just a flash then God speaks, you're going to be able to meet the needs in the body of Christ and you're going to be able to do what God says for you to do without hindrance, without servitude, without bondage to men, hallelujah. Hallelujah, hallelujah.

And sometimes, you've felt like well, Lord, we could have done this. I could have done this. Others do this and others got that and everything. But the Lord keeps dealing with you to do it the slower way because God is maneuvering you and is putting you and your church in a strategic position, a strategic position for this last time revival. And the Lord is going to use this church...I see this church...I see a front line, I see a front line, I see all these soldiers up on the front line. And then over here on this side of the body of Christ is a broken place. There's just broken places where they're running out of ammunition and equipment to

fight their battle. And the Lord says, "New Covenant, run to the rescue, run up on the front lines. Take the message, take the message, take the equipment. Take the reinforcements. Take the supply." And I just see that you're doing that. And that part of the front line of God is fine. And then, over here all of a sudden there's a break, there's a weakness and the Lord says, "New Covenant, go-do this. Do this. Touch this one. Minister to that one. Do this...do this." And I see that the Lord is going to cause you to weave in and weave out and to sort of like the tide comes in and comes out. And you're going to go in and touch this church and you're going to minister to this church and you're going to affect this part of the body of Christ. And then, that will last for a season. And I see that the Lord is just going to use you. And a lot of times the people of God think that once you start something, you have to continue on that wave-length forever. But the Lord says He's going to give you and your church grace to be able to know when and how long to get involved in something. Hallelujah. When to supply and when to drop back, hallelujah. And to look for other ground and other soil to sow into.

But I just see that the Lord is going to use you in a real flexible way. And you're going to have to be in season and out of season. You're going to have to be always on an alert status. But the Lord says, he's going to make you a relief corps. He's going to make you a military airlift command. He's going to make you a supply line...a supply line. And I'm not just talking about -finances, but I see God using you like a Red Cross. Hallelujah. Like a Red Cross, in a supportive role in the body of Christ. Hallelujah. Hallelujah, Lord Jesus.

The outstanding character in the story of the prodigal was the father. He was the father. The story of the Prodigal Son is not the prodigal son. It's not about the prodigal's brother. It's about the faith of the father. The Lord told me this just to encourage you guys. Some are early bloomers and some are late bloomers, but because you have a covenant with God, bloom she will. Amen? Bloom she will. I just kept on thinking. Some children choose to be sensible. Other children in a time in their life have to come to their senses.

Amen? Amen? And I just want to encourage you guys and in no way mean to make you feel embarrassed or awkward, but I want to encourage you, Pastor Russ and Faye. You've done a great job. And you've got a covenant with God. Be like the prodigal's father. The prodigal's father didn't say, "Oh no! I can't let my son go." The prodigal's father stood and said, "No big deal. He's going to learn some of the things the hard way." And you know something? The prodigal's father had so much assurance that he was in covenant with God and that his children would turn out right, that the moment he saw the kid

way off over yonder, he was already looking in faith for that child. "I know my child's going to show up anytime. My child's going to show up anytime, back to his senses." Amen?
